
Introduction

This document describes how to send broadcast messages to all the tenants/users that use Cisco CloudCenter.

How to send broadcast messages to all users in Cisco CloudCenter?

This can be quickly achieved by these steps:

1. **Login** to the super admin user/osmosix admin user with default username/password set by Cisco CloudCenter.
2. Navigate to **System Broadcast** and click on **Add new** button in order to create a broadcast message.



3. Fill the form with the required information.

4. Save the new message form. The newly created form would look similar to this image.
