This document discusses if external Lightweight Directory Access Protocol (LDAP) groups can be added to a group created in the composite domain in the Cisco Information Server (CIS).

## Is it possible to create a group under the composite domain that contains external groups in CIS?

If you want to create a group that contains other external groups, you should do that in the external LDAP server itself. Then you can pull the external super group into CIS.

You cannot add external groups to a group in composite domain.

You can however add external users from the external domain into a group in the composite domain.
