## Introduction

This document explains why edits are ignored when the composite\_server.sh file is modified to alter the way the server starts. This behavior is seen in Cisco Information Server (CIS) Version 7.0 and later.

## Explanation

In CIS Version 7.0 and later, the monitor daemon forks a child process that becomes the server process, and no longer calls the /bin/composite\_server.sh file (or .bat file if on Microsoft Windows) in order to launch a server process.

You can still manually run the composite\_server.sh script if you need to start a server alone in the foreground without running a monitor daemon. However, this is typically done in order to troubleshoot and test and is not for normal use.
