# **Change Calendar Compiles**

In order to change the internal default Calendar compile time, add a new row to the Admiral database table sysval to contain sysval\_id 112 and set sysval\_integer to value that indicates the number of days to wait between calendar compiles. In order to disable automatic Calendar compiles, set sysval\_integer to -1.
