## Q. What does the 'Conferences on this system are managed by a Conference Controller' message mean?

A TelePresence Server can be a standalone TelePresence Server, a Conference Controller TelePresence Server, or a TelePresence Server that is controlled. One Conference Controller can control a number of TelePresence Servers.
