

# How can I enable Network Address Translation (NAT) in a Cisco License On-Prem (CLP) deployment?

## Introduction

This document specifies the step by step process to enable Network Address Translation (NAT) in Cisco License On-Prem (CLP).

## Prerequisites

Before you start, ensure that you have the following:

- A Cisco Smart Account
- A valid CCO User ID and Password that has access to the Smart Account or Virtual Account.
- Admin Access to Cisco License On-Prem (CLP)

## Steps

NAT is supported by SLP devices. To enable:

Step 1: Open Cisco Licensing On-Prem (CLP) & Navigate to Admin Workspace ([https://\(IP Address\):8443/admin/#/mainview](https://(IP Address):8443/admin/#/mainview))

Step 2: Click on Settings and navigate to the *CSLU Tab*.

Step 3: Select the *Enable NAT (Network Address Translation) setup* checkbox to activate the setup. This feature is disabled by default

Step 4: Click *Apply*.
