## Introduction

This document describes how to change the language of Secure Endpoint GUI.

## Prerequisites

## Configure

With the introduction of Secure Client (Secure Endpoint 8) there is the possibility to display GUI in one of the listed languages (the list is subject to change, please verify Release Notes for supported languages):

#### Check current system locale

Check System Locale in Windows. Open Run application and execute **msinfo32** to open System Information:



Within System Information window, you can see System Locale under **System Summary >** Locale:

#### **Configure system locale**

To change Secure Endpoint language, we need to change System Locale. The same procedure applies to Windows 10 and Windows 11.

It can be done in Control Panel > Region > Administrative > Change system locale



Caution: Change of System Locale requires a reboot.

#### Verify the GUI language

This example shows what happens after the change of System Locale to German:



Select which language (system locale) to use when displaying text in programs that do not support Unicode. This setting affects all user accounts on the computer.
