- Secure Firewall Management Center (FMC) with version 7.7.0.
- Secure Firewall Devices (FTD) with version 7.7.0.

The information in this document was created from the devices in a specific lab environment. All of the devices used in this document started with a cleared (default) configuration. If your network is live, ensure that you understand the potential impact of any command.

Background Information


Insufficient disk space can lead to reduced performance, hinder system upgrades, and heighten the risk of unintentionally deleting critical files during space recovery efforts.

This new utility allows you to click to safely remove unneeded files such as old backups, content updates, and troubleshooting files.

Troubleshoot

Step 1.


Log in to the FMC and if the alert shows the message about Disk Usage in any device, navigate to **Health Monitor** dashboard, and select the **Health Monitor** button at the bottom of the **Notifications Tab**.

Step 2.


From the list of devices, locate and select the **Device** displaying the alert (either FMC or FTD) in the left column. In this example, the FMC is the **Device** with the alert.

Step 3.


Navigate to the **bottom of the dashboard** and select the **Clear Disk Space** button in the **Disk Usage Widget**.

Step 4.

Choose the type of **Files** from the list that delete it.



Files to Delete

Step 5.

Confirm by selecting the Clear button in the prompt message.




After confirm, the utility deletes the Files, and after a few seconds a message displays the amount of free space.

Verify

After approximately five minutes, review the **Health Monitor** Dashboard for the targeted **Device**. The alert can no longer be present.
