

Add an Enable/Disable Menu Option in Umbrella Roaming Client OS X

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Introduction

This document describes how to add a manual disable/enable option to the Umbrella Roaming Client menu bar on macOS for testing and troubleshooting.

Feature Availability

- The manual disable and enable menu option is only available for macOS.
- Windows users can disable the Umbrella Roaming Client manually, but there is no option to add a menu item in the tray icon dropdown.

Pre-Installation Method

Use this method if the Umbrella roaming client is not yet installed and you want the disable/enable option available after installation.


1. Download the Umbrella roaming client from the dashboard.
2. Extract the .zip file and open the OrgInfo.plist file with a text editor.
3. Add these two lines immediately before the last two lines of the file (</dict> and </plist>). Ensure the indentation matches the other values.

```
<key>EnableDisableOption</key>  
<true/>
```

4. **Save** the file.
5. Install the **Umbrella Roaming Client** as usual.

Post-Installation Method

Use this method if the Umbrella roaming client is already installed and you want to add the disable/enable option without reinstalling.



Caution: You must use "sudo", because modifying the file requires administrative privileges.

1. Open this file using `vim` or another text editor with administrative privileges:

```
sudo vim /Library/Application\ Support/OpenDNS\ Roaming\ Client/Updater.plist
```

2. Add these two lines immediately before the last two lines of the file (`</dict>` and `</plist>`):

```
<key>EnableDisableOption</key>  
<true/>
```

3. **Save** the file.

After saving, the **Disable** option appears in the tray icon. When disabled, the text updates to show the

Umbrella Roaming Client is disabled and provides an option to enable it.
