What are the parameters that are passed in the end user notification redirection URL?

In the end user notification redirection URL, the following parameters are defined:

Time (Date and Time)

ID (Transaction ID)

Client\_IP (IP address of the client)

User (Username if available else)

Site (Hostname of the destination)

URI (URL\_Path)

Status\_Code (HTTP Status Code)

Decision\_Tag (ACL Decision Tag)

URL\_Cat (URL Category)

WBRS (WBRS Score)

DVS\_Verdict (DVS Verdict Score)

DVS\_ThreatName (DVS Threat Name)
