New and Changed Information

The table below summarizes the new and changed features for the Cisco Network Visibility application on Cisco APIC-EM Release 1.4.0.x that are covered in this document. Feature	Description	Where Documented
Update Polling Interval	You can update the polling interval at the global level for all devices on the Settings > Polling Interval page or at the device level for a specific device in the Device Inventory window. When you set the polling interval at the device level, that value takes precedence over the global polling interval value.	Updating a Device's Polling Interval
Update Credentials	You can change the credentials of the selected devices.	Updating Device Credentials
Resync (Resynchronize Devices)	Immediately polls the selected device for updated device information and status.	Resynchronizing Device Information
Command Runner	Sends CLI commands to the selected devices using API commands. Currently, show and other read-only commands are permitted.	Running Commands on Devices
IP Device Tracking (IPDT)	Retrieves host information during the discovery process.	IP Device Tracking Configuration
