Prefix Advertisement

This alarm rule detects when a prefix is advertised and reports if it exceeds the threshold trigger.



Note

It is useful to know which of your peers may be doing something wrong (leaking route information or having some type of misconfiguration) so that you can address the problem right away. A **My Peers** rule is available for this alarm with certain [Crosswork Cloud subscriptions](#). The **My Peers** option follows BGP updates *only* from your [peers](#), whereas **All Peers** follow BGP updates from your peers *and* global peers. Possible Problem Detected

This alarm helps identify a route leak or unexpected change for a configured prefix.
