



# Release Notes for Cisco Business Dashboard, Version 2.5.1

## Introduction

These release notes describe the recommended practices and known issues that apply to software version 2.5.1 of Cisco Business Dashboard.

## What's New in Cisco Business Dashboard Release 2.5.1

Cisco Business Dashboard release 2.5.1 with a build date of December 2nd 2022 resolves a problem where an upgrade to 2.5.1 may fail. This issue was reported as CSCwd79604.

Cisco Business Dashboard release 2.5.1 introduces the following new features and changes:

- Support has been added for centralized Guest Portals hosted by the dashboard. Configuration of Guest Portals is only supported for CBWxxx access points.
- Due to the recent end of life of the Cisco Active Advisor service, the CAA integration and product improvement features have been removed from the dashboard.
- The language used for messages and text notes in third-party integrations may now be selected from the list of languages supported by the GUI.
- The web user interface supports the following languages:
  - Simplified Chinese
  - French
  - German
  - Japanese
  - Spanish

## Caveats

The following table lists the open caveats for Cisco Business Dashboard version 2.5.1.

Table 1: Open Caveats

Caveat ID Number	Headline
<a href="#">CSCvc04204</a>	Getting the duplicated entry in the credentials table for switch stack after power off the master. <b>Workaround</b> When the stack is stable, reboot Probe.
<a href="#">CSCvf49309</a>	CBD displays an outside WAN IP instead of the device IP on Network Plug and Play - Unclaimed Devices page. <b>Workaround</b> None
<a href="#">CSCvf49332</a>	CBD responses are slow when the display is over 300 hosts on the topology page. <b>Workaround</b> Don't display the hosts when there are that many.
<a href="#">CSCvq25771</a>	Cisco Business Dashboard does not sync time from VirtualBox. <b>Workaround</b> Install VirtualBox Guest Additions in the virtual machine with the command 'sudo apt-get install -y virtualbox-guest-utils' and reboot the virtual machine. <b>Note</b> The presence of VirtualBox Guest Additions in the virtual machine will prevent timesyncd from running and NTP will not function. VirtualBox Guest Additions must be removed to sync time using NTP.
<a href="#">CSCvq25807</a>	Stack switch unit configuration is missing after master recovery from offline. <b>Workaround</b> Manually read and accept current config or wait for the daily schedule job.
<a href="#">CSCvq25817</a>	VLAN settings not shown for members of a LAG. <b>Workaround</b> Review the VLAN configuration for the LAG on the device administration GUI.
<a href="#">CSCvv18280</a>	CBD doesn't support "same SSID name" case for CBW. <b>Workaround</b> Ensure SSID names on a single CBW access point cluster are unique.
<a href="#">CSCwa46056</a>	The <b>Delete devices</b> automation ticket should only allow immediate execution. <b>Workaround</b> None.

Caveat ID Number	Headline
CSCwd28277	CBD Probe attempts connection to Dashboard on TCP port 443 instead of specified custom port .
<a href="#">CSCwd79604</a>	CBD upgrade to 2.5.1 may fail.
CSCwd02453	CBD 2.5 issue with port description modification.

## General Limitations

- The web interface on Cisco Business Dashboard takes a few minutes to become operational after the application is started.
- Depending on the size of the network, it may take the Probe several minutes to discover all devices and calculate the network topology.
- Up to 50 network devices can be managed by a single virtual machine or Raspberry Pi Probe instance. Refer to the documentation for the product in question to identify the maximum number of devices supported by an embedded probe running on a Cisco Business network device.
- Up to 2500 devices can be managed by a single Dashboard instance.
- SNMPv3 authentication keys and privacy keys must be at least 8 characters in length
- When using Safari, ensure that the certificate presented by the Cisco Business Dashboard Probe is set to **Always Trust**.
- When you deploy Cisco Business Dashboard as a Microsoft Azure virtual machine, if you select the **Availability options** to enable infrastructure redundancy, the Dashboard will not be able to automatically populate the external IP addresses in the System Variables. The external IP system variables need to be set manually.

**Note** Depending on the way the system has been configured, it may be necessary to regenerate the Dashboard certificate to reference the correct address.

## System Backup and Restore

- When performing a system backup or restore, Cisco Business Dashboard will prevent you from doing any further configuration actions.
- Prior to beginning a system backup or restore, the idle timeout value in **Administration > Users > User Settings** should be set to at least 30 minutes (default is 60 minutes).
