Feature	Description	Where Documented
TCP Syslog Sessions Support	APIC sends a <code>KeepAlive</code> packet over the syslog TCP sessions to ensure the connection is not considered idle or expired.	Creating a Syslog Destination and Destination Group
Local SPAN with the switch CPU as the destination	This feature allows you to send SPAN packets to the CPU port of the leaf switch for packet analysis.	CPU as a destination port for a SPAN session
