| bold | Bold text indicates the commands and keywords that you enter literally <br> as shown. |
| Italic | Italic text indicates arguments for which you supply the values. |
| $[\mathrm{x}]$ | Square brackets enclose an optional element (keyword or argument). |
| $[\mathrm{x} \mid \mathrm{y}]$ | Square brackets enclosing keywords or arguments that are separated by <br> a vertical bar indicate an optional choice. |
| $\{\mathrm{x} \mid \mathrm{y}\}$ | Braces enclosing keywords or arguments that are separated by a vertical <br> bar indicate a required choice. |
| $[\mathrm{x}\{\mathrm{y} \mid \mathrm{z}\}]$ | Nested set of square brackets or braces indicate optional or required <br> choices within optional or required elements. Braces and a vertical bar <br> within square brackets indicate a required choice within an optional <br> element. |

| string | A nonquoted set of characters. Do not use quotation marks around the <br> string or the string includes the quotation marks. |
