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SONiC on Cisco 8000 Series Routers, Release 202505c.1.1.0

Cisco SONiC Release 202505c.1.1.0 introduces support for Network Device Integration: Network Device Configuration Agent, ND Integration: GNMI Configuration Framework Support, and ND Integration Support for ARS. This release enhances the SONiC platform on Cisco 8000 Series routers by improving software reliability and API integration.
