

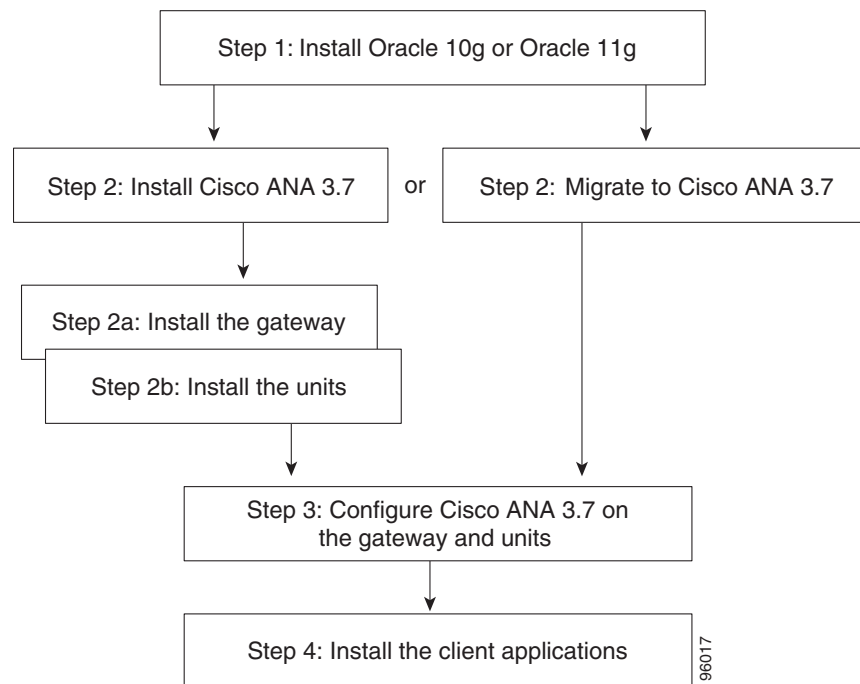


# CHAPTER 3

## Cisco ANA Installation Workflow

Figure 3-1 describes the overall steps required to install Cisco ANA 3.7. Detailed instructions on how to perform each step are provided in subsequent chapters.

**Figure 3-1** Cisco ANA Installation Workflow



1. Install Oracle 10g or Oracle 11g for use with Cisco ANA 3.7. See [Chapter 4, “Creating and Configuring an Oracle Database.”](#)
2. Install Cisco ANA 3.7, as follows:
  - If you are installing Cisco ANA 3.7 for the first time, follow the instructions in [Chapter 5, “Installing a Cisco ANA Gateway,”](#) and [Chapter 6, “Installing a Cisco ANA Unit.”](#)
  - If you are migrating to Cisco ANA 3.7 from an earlier version of Cisco ANA, follow the instructions in [Chapter 9, “Migrating to Cisco ANA 3.7.”](#)

3. Configure Cisco ANA 3.7 on the gateway and units. Use the **ana-conf** script as described in [Installing the Cisco ANA Gateway, page 5-3](#) and [Installing the Cisco ANA Unit, page 6-2](#).
4. Install the required client applications. See [Chapter 7, “Installing Clients.”](#)
