



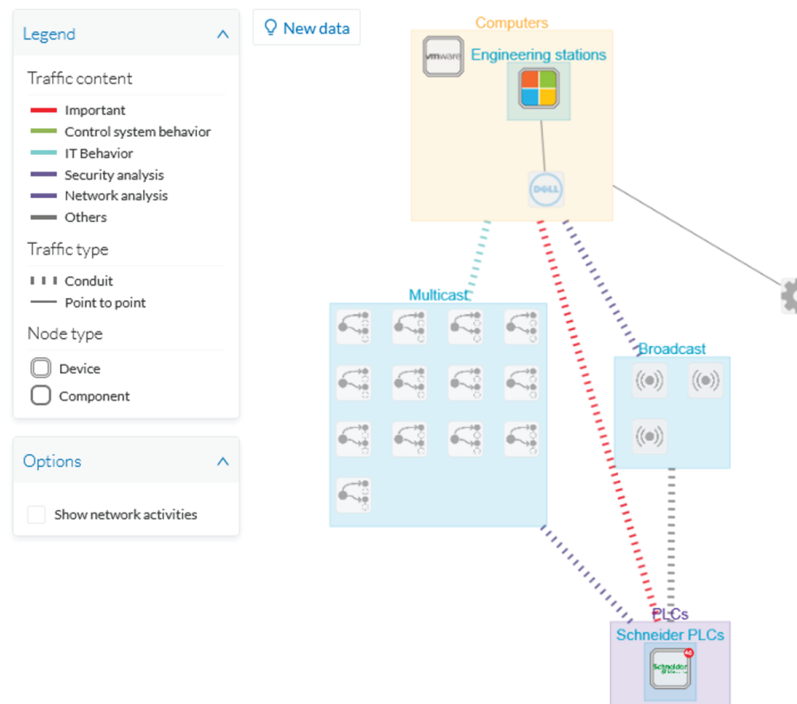

Conduit

A conduit is the representation of the communications exchanged between two [groups](#). It is in fact an aggregation of [activities](#) to facilitate visibility when devices and components are inside groups. Conduits representation in Cisco Cyber Vision fit the 62443 standard which specifies policies and requirements for system security

A conduit is recognizable on the map by a thick, hyphenated line -which can have an arrow if the source and destination groups are known- that links one group to another:



Conduits view mode is enabled by default. You can disable it by using the Show network activities button at the lower left side of the map.
