Thank you for choosing Firepower. These are the Cisco Secure Dynamic Attributes Connector Release Notes.

Version 1.1 of the Cisco Secure Dynamic Attributes Connector includes the following updates and improvements:

- Supported on Ubuntu 20; Red Hat Enterprise Linux (RHEL) 7 and 8; CentOS 7 Linux; as well as Ubuntu 18.
- Supports connectors for Microsoft Office 365 Dynamic Objects; Azure service tags; as well as Amazon Web Services and VMware vCenter.
- Automatically fetches the certificate authority (CA) chains for vCenter and the FMC.
- Tests the connection to connectors and adapters.
- Supports 200 or more connectors if the system is configured with the recommended hardware and memory.
- Improves performance by using bulk upload APIs in FMC 7.1
- Compatible with FMC 7.0 and 7.1
