Chapter	Description
Chapter 1, “Getting Started”	Provides an overview of the Cisco Smart+Connected Meeting Spaces application. It also describes how to view the availability of the conference rooms and book them using the signage or IP phones placed at the actual resource space, in addition to the traditional reservation techniques such as email/calendaring client.
Chapter 2, “Smart+Connected MS Web Portal”	Provides an overview of the Cisco Smart+Connected Meeting Spaces web portal.
Chapter 3, “Booking Rooms Using the Portal”	Describes how to book conference rooms using the portal. It describes the procedure you must follow to book rooms using the Quick Reservation and New Reservation method.

Chapter 4, “Managing Meetings Using the Portal”	Describes how to view, accept, decline, and delete meetings and specify your preferences for conference room booking and other settings.
Chapter 5, “Managing the Conference Room Resources”	Describes how to send messages to the signage, control the devices in a conference room, and release the conference rooms.
