The Video modules enable you to add videos to your sites. This helps the users to access videos directly from your site without opening another video site. The Enterprise Mobility Services Platform enables you to add YouTube videos to your site.

Embed Youtube Video

The Embed YouTube Video module enables you to show videos on your mobile site. This module can be used to embed a single or multiple existing YouTube videos in your mobile site. The user can access the YouTube video on the mobile site itself instead of navigating to the YouTube site separately for viewing it.

Before you begin to use the Embed YouTube Video module, you must have the unique video IDs or unique playlist ID of the YouTube videos that you want to show on the site.

The mobile site can contain a preview or a short demo of the product that is displayed on the site. A getting started video is more effective than a long description of a product. It also retains the interest of the user and provides an enriching visual appeal. To do this, you can embed and display existing YouTube videos on your mobile site using this module.

The following are some of the use cases of this module:

- Embed a movie trailer on the micro-site of a new, unreleased movie.
- Display a product video on the site that advertises the product.

**Note**

This module can be used only for web sites.

Configuring the Embed YouTube Video module

To configure the Embed YouTube Video module, perform the following steps:

-
- Step 1** In the Modules panel, enter **Embed YouTube Video**. The Embed YouTube Video module appears in the Modules panel.
 - Step 2** Drag and drop the **Embed YouTube Video** module onto the Canvas. The Edit panel of the module opens.
 - Step 3** In the Edit panel of the module, specify the required values in the respective fields.
 - Step 4** Click **Save**.

**Note**

This module will not display the video(s) in the canvas area. You have to go to the preview to view the configured module. Click the Preview button to view the preview.

Embed YouTube Video Properties

Main Properties

The Main properties enable you to specify the video details. The following is the list of Embed YouTube Video Main properties.

Table 14-1 Main Properties

Property	Description
Choose Type	The Video ID or Playlist ID depending on what you configures in the module.
Enter Video ID (Single/Multiple comma separated)	The video IDs that you want to configure. You can add multiple video IDs separated by commas. Space must not be there after each comma.
Enter Playlist ID	The Playlist ID that you want to configure. Note You can configure only one playlist in this module.
Play video Repeatedly	To play the videos repeatedly without stopping. Note This option works only when you configure more than one video.

Background Properties

The background properties enable you to specify the background properties for the module. The following is the list of Embed YouTube Video Background properties..

Table 14-2 Background Properties

Property	Description
Overall background options	
Background color	The background color for the area where the video appears.
Background Image Option	Add Background Image (Touch)—To add an image as background for the are where the video appears for touch mode. You can add the image using the Upload Image option. Add Background Image (Non-Touch)—To add an image as background for the area where the video appears for non-touch mode. You can add the image using the Upload Image option. Repeat Horizontally only—To repeat the background image horizontally only.
Use CSS gradient for background (Touch)	To add a gradient effect for the module background.

Table 14-2 Background Properties

Property	Description
Background gradient color (Top) (Touch)	The color for the top corner radius to create a gradient effect for the background. If the same color is selected for both top and bottom, then the background will be plain.
Background gradient color (Bottom) (Touch)	The color for the bottom corner radius to create a gradient effect for the background. If the same color is selected for both top and bottom, then the background will be plain.

Border Properties

The border properties enable you to specify the border properties for the Embed YouTube Video module. The following is the list of Embed YouTube Video Border properties.

Table 14-3 Border Properties

Property	Description
Border Color	The border color for the video module.
Stroke Weight (Px)	The thickness for the border line.
Top corner-radius (Px) (Touch)	The value to apply a rounded corner effect to the top corners for touch devices.
Bottom corner-radius (Px) (Touch)	The value to apply a rounded corner effect to the bottom corners for non-touch devices.

Padding and Margin Properties

The padding and margin properties enable you to specify the padding and margin values for the Embed YouTube Video module. The following is the list of Embed YouTube Video Padding and Margin properties.

Table 14-4 Padding and Margin Properties

Property	Description
Padding (Px) (Touch)	The space between the content boundary and the module border for touch mode.
Padding (Px) (Non-touch)	The space between the content boundary and the module border for non-touch mode.
Margin (Px) (Touch)	The space between the module boundary and the sides of device screen for touch mode.
Margin (Px) (Non-touch)	The space between the module boundary and the sides of device screen for non-touch mode.
