



## G Commands

---

This chapter describes the Cisco Nexus Cloud Services Platform commands that begin with the letter G.

### gunzip

To uncompress a compressed file, use the **gunzip** command.

**gunzip** *filename*

#### Syntax Description

<i>filename</i>	Name of a file. The filename is case sensitive.

#### Usage Guidelines

The compressed filename must have the .gz extension.  
You do not have to enter the .gz extension as part of the filename.  
The Cisco NX-OS software uses Lempel-Ziv 1977 (LZ77) coding for compression.

#### Examples

This example shows how to uncompress a compressed file:

```
n1010# gunzip run_cfg.cfg
```

# gzip

To compress a file, use the **gzip** command.

**gzip** *filename*

<b>Usage Guidelines</b>	After you use this command, the file is replaced with the compressed filename that has the .gz extension. The Cisco NX-OS software uses Lempel-Ziv 1977 (LZ77) coding for compression.
