Ingress Policing	6.0(2)N1(1)	Policing allows you to monitor the data rates for a particular class of traffic. When the data rate exceeds user-configured values, the switch drops packets immediately. Because policing does not buffer the traffic; transmission delays are not affected. When traffic exceeds the data rate, you instruct the system to drop the packets.
