unset eventcontrol all

`unset eventcontrol all`

Syntax Description None

Command Modes Admin

Command History	Release	Modifications
	1.6	This command was first documented.

Usage Guidelines Use this command to unset all system and active meeting event control settings.

Examples `admin:unset eventcontrol all`

unset eventcontrol meeting

`unset network dns options meeting_id`

Syntax Description	<i>meeting_id</i>	Defaults the wait time before considering a Domain Name System (DNS) query to have failed.

Usage Guidelines	Use this command to unset all event control settings for the specified meeting.
-------------------------	---

Examples	<code>admin:unset eventcontrol meeting 12345</code>
-----------------	---

unset network dns options

unset network dns options [**timeout**] [**attempts**] [**rotate**]

Syntax Description

timeout	Defaults the wait time before considering a Domain Name System (DNS) query to have failed.
attempts	Defaults the number of attempts to make before failing.
rotate	Defaults the method for selecting a name server; this affects how loads are distributed across name servers.

Release	Modifications

Usage Guidelines

Use this command to unset the Domain Name System (DNS) options. This command causes a temporary loss of network connections.

Examples

```
admin:unset network dns options timeout
      ***  W A R N I N G  ***
This will cause the system to temporarily lose network connectivity

      Do you want to continue ?

Enter "yes" to continue or any other key to abort
yes
executing...
admin:show workingdir
```
