



AXL Configuration

Use AXL configuration settings to configure the username and password for AXL Application Programming Interface (API) access. You can use the AXL Configuration window to change the AXL username and password that you entered during installation.

Configuring AXL Settings

This section describes how to configure the AXL username and password.



Caution

You must enter the username and password for the application user that has the Standard AXL API Access role assigned to it on the associated Cisco Unified CallManager first node. By default, the Standard AXL API Access role gets assigned to the CCMAdministrator User ID.

Procedure

- Step 1** Choose **Cisco Unified Presence Server > Security > AXL Configuration**.
The AXL Configuration window displays.
 - Step 2** Enter the AXL username and password.
 - Step 3** Confirm the AXL password.
 - Step 4** To save your settings, click the **Save** icon that displays in the tool bar in the upper, left corner of the window (or click the **Save** button that displays at the bottom of the window).
