1 Entering Cisco Unified MeetingPlace Express

Use the following commands for performing common tasks, *before* you join a meeting, such as getting assistance, joining and starting a meeting, accessing your profile, and selecting a primary language (if available on your system).

Use the following commands for performing tasks *after* you have joined a meeting, such as going to a breakout session, hearing a roll call, ending and exiting a meeting, and bringing new participants in to the meeting.
