


Remote Server List Configuration Mode Commands



address

	Configures or removes an IP address to a remote server.
Product	All
Privilege	Security Administrator, Administrator
Command Modes	Exec > Global Configuration > Remote Server List Configuration
	<pre>configure > context context_name > remote-server-list name list_name</pre>
	[context_name]host_name(config-remote-server-list)#
Syntax Description	<pre>address remote-ip-address netmask ip_netmask no address remote-ip-address netmask ip_netmask</pre>

	Removes the specified IP address from the Remote Server List.
	<i>remote-ip-address</i> netmask <i>ip_netmask</i>
	Specifies the IP address and netmask of the remote server in IPv4 dotted-decimal or IPv6 colon-separated-hexadecimal notation.
Usage Guidelines	Use this command to create and maintain a list of remote servers accessible by this context.
	Example
	address 193.154.78.9 netmask 255.255.255.0

do show

	Executes all show commands while in Configuration mode.
Product	All
Privilege	Security Administrator, Administrator
Syntax Descripti	on do show
Usage Guideline	Use this command to run all Exec mode show commands while in Configuration mode. It is not necessary to exit the Config mode to run a show command.
	The pipe character is only available if the command is valid in the Exec mode.
Cau	There are some Exec mode show commands which are too resource intensive to run from Config mode. These include: do show support collection , do show support details , do show support record and do show support summary . If there is a restriction on a specific show command, the following error message is displayed:
	Failure: Cannot execute 'do show support' command from Config mode.

end

Exits the current configuration mode and returns to the Exec mode.

exit

Exits the current mode and returns to the parent configuration mode.

Usage Guidelines	Use this command to return to the parent configuration mode.
