



Network Service Virtual Connection Configuration Mode Commands

Command Modes

The Network Service Virtual Connection (NSVC) configuration mode is a sub-mode of the Network Service Entity (NSE) - Peer NSEI (for Frame Relay) configuration mode. The NSVC sub-mode creates a configuration instance for a specific NSVC, within the Gb interface, between a BSS and an SGSN in a 2.5G GPRS Frame Relay network connection.

Exec > Global Configuration > Network Service Entity - Frame Relay Peer NSEI Configuration > NSVC Configuration

configure > network-service-entity peer-nsei *peer_nsei* framerelay > ns-vc *nsvc_id*

Entering the above command sequence results in the following prompt:

```
[local] host_name(nse-fr-peer-nsei-nse_id-nsvci-nsvc_instance) #
```
