# **Information About Interim Accounting**

RADIUS accounting sends accounting-request packets, with the relevant accounting information, from the network access server (NAS) to a RADIUS server.



Note

The RADIUS accounting requests send data, such as VLAN ID, authentication methods, and so on, to a session.

RADIUS accounting covers the following updates:

- **Interim Updates**: When RADIUS accounting covers DHCP\_TLVs, HTTP\_TLVs, IP, or ROAM (state machine) changes, the updates are referred to as interim updates or interim accounting.
- **Periodic Updates**: When RADIUS accounting is specified by a timer value, the updates are referred to as periodic updates.



Note

Disable the interim updates for the following reasons:

- They cause unnecessary traffic to be sent.
- They drive up error rates.
- They impact alarm thresholds and other metrics that are used for venue-authentication performance.

By default, the Interim Accounting feature is enabled with the **aaa accounting Identity default start-stop group radius** command.

### **Disabling Interim Accounting (CLI)**

You must disable the Policy Profile before performing this procedure.

#### **Procedure**

	Command or Action	Purpose
Step 1	configure terminal	Enters global configuration mode.
	Example:	
	Device# configure terminal	
Step 2	wireless profile policy profile-policy	Configures WLAN policy profile and enters wireless policy configuration mode.
	Example:	
	Device(config)# wireless profile policy default-policy-profile	
Step 3	no accounting-interim	Disables interim accounting.
	Example:	
	Device(config-wireless-policy)# no accounting-interim	
Step 4	end	Returns to privileged EXEC mode.
	Example:	
	Device(config-wireless-policy)# end	

# **Verifying Interim Accounting**

To verify the interim accounting updates, run the following command:

Device# show wireless profile policy detailed default-policy-profile  $\mid$  s Interim Interim Accounting Updates: DISABLED
