db balance

Configures the Balance database.

Privilege Security Administrator, Administrator

Command Modes Exec > Global Config

Syntax Description `db balance shard-count balance_db_shard_count`

`shard-count balance_db_shard_count`

Specify the Balance database's shard count.

Must be an integer.

Default Value: 1.

Usage Guidelines Use this command to configure the Balance database.

Example

The following command configures the Balance database's shard count to 1:

```
db balance shard-count 1
```

db global-settings

Configures global DB settings.

Privilege	Security Administrator, Administrator
Command Modes	Exec > Global Config
Syntax Description	<p>global-settings db-replica <i>replica_count</i></p> <p>db-replica <i>replica_count</i></p> <p>Specify the global DB replica count.</p> <p>Must be an integer.</p> <p>Default Value: 3.</p>
Usage Guidelines	Use this command to configure the global DB settings.

db global-settings timers

Configures global MongoDB timers.

Privilege	Security Administrator, Administrator
Command Modes	Exec > Global Config
Syntax Description	<p>db global-settings timers { catchup-timeout-millis <i>catchup_timeout</i> election-timeout-millis <i>election_timeout</i> heartbeat-interval-millis <i>heartbeat_interval</i> }</p> <p>heartbeat-interval-millis <i>heartbeat_interval</i></p> <p>Specify the global heartbeat interval period, in milliseconds.</p> <p>Must be an integer.</p> <p>Default Value: 300.</p> <p>catchup-timeout-millis <i>catchup_timeout</i></p> <p>Specify the global catchup timeout period, in milliseconds.</p> <p>Must be an integer.</p> <p>Default Value: 2000.</p> <p>election-timeout-millis <i>election_timeout</i></p> <p>Specify the global election timeout period, in milliseconds.</p> <p>Must be an integer.</p> <p>Default Value: 2000.</p>
Usage Guidelines	Use this command to configure the global MongoDB timers.

db spr

Configures the SPR database.

Privilege Security Administrator, Administrator

Command Modes Exec > Global Config

Syntax Description **db spr shard-count** *shard_count*

shard-count *shard_count*

Specify the SPR database's shard count.

Must be an integer.

Default Value: 1.

Usage Guidelines Use this command to configure the SPR database.

Example

The following command configures the SPR database's shard count to 20:

```
db spr shard-count 20
```
