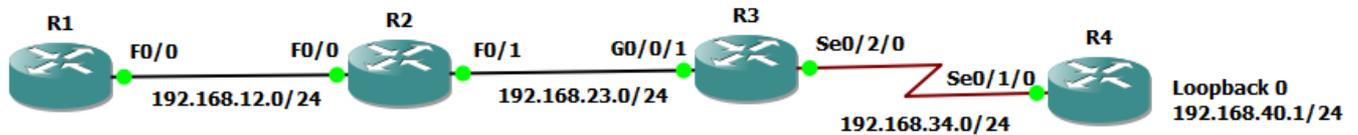
Configureren

Deze methoden zijn beschikbaar om de standaardroute in Ecu te adverteren die in dit artikel wordt uitgelegd:

1. Gebruik standaardroute en herdistributie

2. Gebruik overzichtsadres

Netwerkdigram



Configuratie

Hier worden de routers R1, R2 en R3 gevormd met Ecu en geen Ecu loopt binnen tussen R3 en R4.

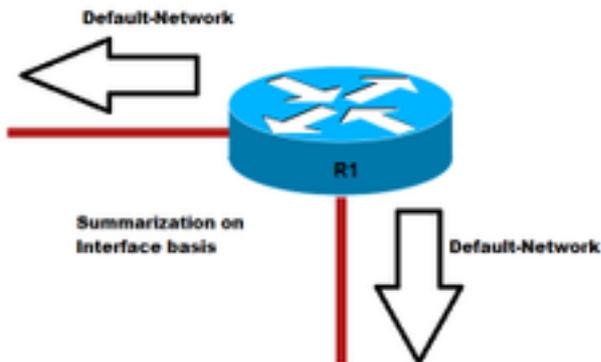
